CHAPTER BUSINESS:

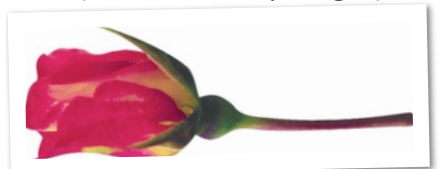
At the September meeting we voted on changes to the Bylaws. Revised version is posted online.
